The International Geosynthetics Society (IGS) is a non-profit organization which was founded in Paris, on 10 November 1983, by a group of geotechnical engineers and textile specialists. The society brings together individual and corporate members from all parts of the world, who are involved in the design, manufacture, sale, use or testing of geotextiles, geomembranes, related products and associated technologies, or who teach or conduct research about such products.

The strength of the IGS lies in diversity and strong local leadership. Our society is comprised of 47 hard-working National and Regional Chapters and includes members from over 70 countries! We are pleased to report that at the time of this brochure there are a number of additional chapters in formation.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION

Membership of the Society is open to Individuals or Corporations "...engaged in, or associated with, the research, development, teaching, design, manufacture or use of geotextiles, geomembranes and related products or systems and their applications, or otherwise interested in such matters." The annual fee for membership is (US) \$1000 for Corporate Members. New Corporate Members must also pay a joining/administrative fee of \$300. New Corporate Members are defined as any company who was not a member in good-standing in the prior calendar year.

Individuals or Corporations who voluntarily contribute a minimum of (US) \$200 annually to the Society, in excess of their membership dues, will be mentioned in the IGS website in a separate list as an IGS Benefactor.

Annual IGS Corporate Member dues are \$1,000 per year and are billed on a calendar year. Companies who join after July 1st will have the current year pro-rated to a rate of \$500. Companies who

join after July 1st will join for the remainder of the current year as well as the following year. The total cost for the two years (pro-ratedis \$1,500, due at the time of joining. Companies who fail to pay their annual invoice before May 1st will be assessed a \$100 late fee.
